The minutes of the meeting were as follows:

Resolution 1: Dr. Jayasree Nambiar read the minutes of the previous IQAC meeting and they were confirmed.

Resolution 2: Cultural coordinator Dr. Nambiar presented a review of the annual social gathering and prize distribution function Spandan-2019 organized by BCACS on 19 January 2019.

Resolution 3: Dr. Nilesh Patil and Prof. Kulkarni presented the syllabus completion status of BBA and BCom respectively. Dr. Shitole asked them to ensure that nothing is pending as university exams are fast approaching.

Resolution 4: IQAC coordinator Dr. Nambiar update the committee on the NAAC preparation status of BCACS. It was decided to work together as a team to prepare for NAAC.
